Indoor/outdoor Session - Spring 2010

Developmental & Pre-Competitive Program

Registration begins February 8th. Forms may be picked up from and submitted to the Front Desk or Racquets Office before March 8th. You will be contacted after March 8th regarding your child's status in the program. Classes will start the week of March 15th and run for 13 weeks at \$16 per session, finishing on June 19th (total \$208 + GST). *Please note: due to rainouts, holidays and other Club activities, lessons may be cancelled. Lessons will not be re-scheduled or made-up during the term. Billings will be pro-rated.

Court Kittens (4-6 years) – ½ Court Tennis

A fun and active introductory class that focuses on developing the ABC'S (Agility, Balance, Coordination and Speed) on the tennis court, as well as introducing the basic fundamentals of tennis. Progressive Tennis Equipment is used.

Court Cats (6-8 years) – ½ Court Tennis

Children will build on their ABC'S and the basic fundamentals of tennis to help them rally and play points with one another. Progressive Tennis Equipment is used.

Novice/Intermediate - A fun class that focuses on building the basic strokes of tennis while learning how to rally and play points with one another. Partner and group work is emphasized.

Intermediate/Advanced - For children that have developed half-court rally skills and are beginning to play points with assistance.

Rookie 1-2-3 (8-10 years) – ¾ Court Tennis

With 3 levels for progression (Novice, Intermediate and Advanced), Juniors are developing and refining their fundamentals and are encouraged to play points and enjoy rallying as much as possible. Low-compression balls and a modified court are used to encourage Juniors to play "real" tennis.

Novice – For players that are becoming comfortable rallying, controlling the ball and are working toward their first ¾ Fun Event.

Intermediate – For players that have participated in a couple of ¾ Fun Events and Sunday Match-Plays, and are confident playing points on their own.

Advanced – For players that have participated in many ¾ Fun Events and Sunday Match-Plays, and are looking to compete in their first RIX Rookie Tour Event. Additional practice outside of lesson time is greatly emphasized.

Futures 1-2 (11+ years) and Teen Tennis (13+ years) – Full Court Tennis

Whether a competitive or recreational player, Juniors are encouraged to play points and enjoy rallying as much as possible. Futures classes are often a transitional class for players working toward competitive tennis events (Challenger Level) and striving to get into the High Performance Program. Players that have graduated from the Rookie 1-2-3 levels may be placed in the Futures classes according to their tennis goals and skill level.

Drop-In Tennis (dates will be available online)

Saturdays 2:15 to 3:30pm – An open, unsupervised time for Junior members to practice their match-play skills with each other.

Sundays 6:00 to 8:00pm – Family Tennis (the 1st Sunday of each month) – This time is for parents and their children to play together. Children of Members are welcome.

Sundays 6:00 to 8:00pm – Sunday Junior/Parent Tennis – To allow Junior members to practice their skills under the guidance and assistance of their parents. Please adhere to the 20-minute wait rule if the courts are busy.
